### Interdisciplinary Approaches and Scientific Methods in Viking Studies

The 42<sup>nd</sup> Interdisciplinary Viking Symposium is devoted to contributions dealing with new interdisciplinary and scientific methods in Viking research. Papers dealing with traditional scholarly disciplines within Viking research such as archaeology, history, philology etc. may also be taken into consideration.

Interdisciplinary methods have for many years been used in archaeology in order to better visualize the past. In recent decades, many new scientific methods have been introduced, such as aDNA, protein, isotope, and lipids as well as methods used in bioarcheology and osteology. Similarly, digital tools and methods have become increasingly important for the researchers and naturally this has led to a deeper understanding and multifaceted picture of the Viking Age.

The 42<sup>nd</sup> Interdisciplinary Viking Symposium takes place Friday 16th May 2025 at the University of Copenhagen's Southern Campus in Njalsgade entrance 4A. Key-note speakers are allotted 20-30 minute presentations, whereas other presentations will be allotted 15-25 minutes. Please allow 3 to 5 minutes for questions and discussion.

All presentations will be held in a room with audio-visual and computer equipment and will be transmitted via Zoom.

Abstracts should be submitted to the organizing committee as soon as possible and no later than March 15, 2025. Abstracts must include a title and a maximum of 500 words. Papers should be in English.
